SAMPLE COMPARISON EXCERPT

A comparison starts with the deployment, not the map.

The same commercial objective can produce different transfer routes, governance steps and evidence requirements. This sample shows the decision framing without reproducing the paid analysis or source register.

01 | UAE FEDERAL

Identify the lawful route and safeguards

A transfer may be possible, but the team must select and document the route that fits the actual data flow, recipient and safeguards.

Decision question: what leaves the UAE, where does it go, and which transfer basis is being relied on?

02 | DIFC

Match the transfer mechanism to the processing

Adequacy, safeguards or a permitted derogation must fit the real movement of personal data. Autonomous systems can add a separate governance layer.

Decision question: is the deployment only a transfer issue, or does AI-specific processing governance also apply?

03 | SAUDI ARABIA

Map transfer controls with sector overlays

The PDPL and Transfer Regulation need to be considered alongside sector and localization requirements. A blanket statement that data cannot leave is not a reliable conclusion.

Decision question: which transfer mechanism, risk assessment and sector constraints apply to this workload?
